**Reservations of food stalls - Holi Mahotsav 2020
incorporating festivities of Vaisakhi and Easter**

[STRICTLY VEGETARIAN FOOD ONLY CAN BE SOLD/SERVED]

The participation costs for two days are:

- There will be 1 fridge for every 2 stalls, 1 washing basin for every 2 stoves, cooking marquee is 6m x 3m and addition safety measures will have to be observed.
- **Food stall for 2 days:** 4-5 of April 2020 (from 12pm to 8pm on 4 April Saturday and 11am to 8pm on 5 April Sunday) and food license from Sydney City Council: **\$2200.00 or \$1500.00 for Sunday alone.**
- In addition to the cost of the stall, a Refundable (subject to conditions) bond amount of \$350 is payable with the final payment.

In the interest of all our stall owners we will be limiting to only 8 food stalls and 20 merchandise stalls. The full stalls will be permitted. Drinks have to be located in a separated fridge. Branded drinks can not be sold cheaper than official vendors who will have 1 trolley on each entrance of Festival.

Booking for the stalls will be accepted on a first-come first served basis. The initial booking form is attached. **The booking for the stall should be done latest by the 28 February 2020 with full payment.**

The Sydney Harbour Foreshore Authority has certain formalities including the standard application forms for the stalls to be completed. These forms will be completed after your booking confirmation has been received. We also offer various other sponsorship opportunities including advertisement in the souvenir edition of our monthly magazine Bhavan Australia.
